◆Applicant Requirements◆

Applicant needs to fulfill the following conditions as of the application date.

- ①International student* currently enrolled at a university, college, Japanese language school, vocational school which belongs to “Study Kyoto”network *International Student who holds a student visa
- ②Passionate to introduce the attractiveness of Kyoto to students in his/her home country
※Production skills for promotional material(flyers, movies etc.) are welcomed.
- ③Able to understand Japanese(Meetings will be conducted in Japanese)
- ④Able to work in shift at the Campus Plaza Kyoto(2-3 times/month, approx.3hours each)
- ⑤Able to work throughout the fiscal year 2015 (from July 2015 to March 2016)
- ⑥Have “Permission to Engage in an Activity Other Than That Permitted by the Status of Residence Previously Granted” (Shikakugai katsudo kyoka), which allows student visa holders to work part-time jobs that do not exceed 28 hours a week
